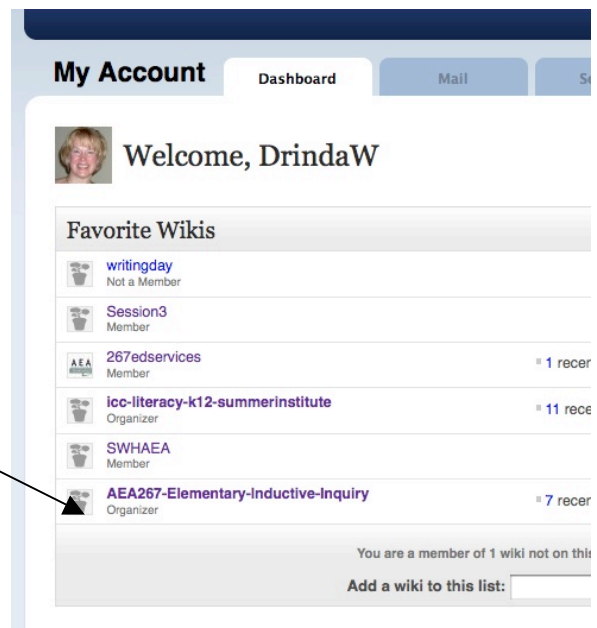

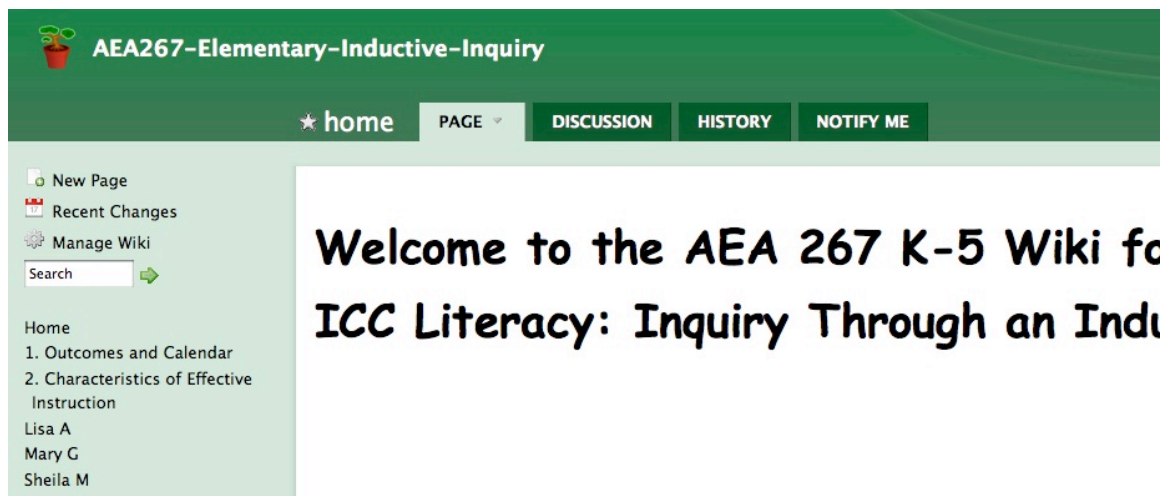

This will take you to the Wiki home page, which looks like this:

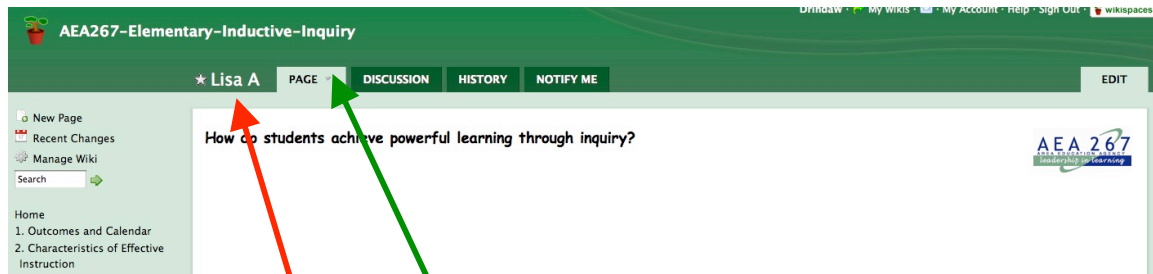


We've put up some pages to help you keep track of the class:

Here is a sample page:

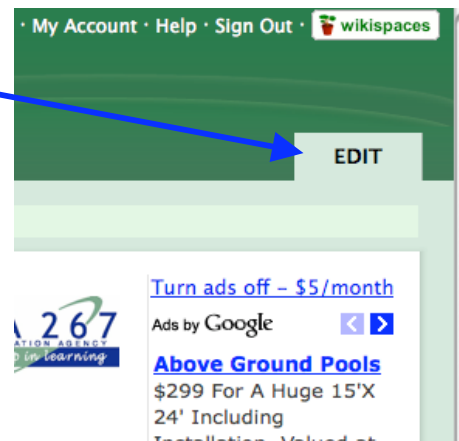


Notice that your **name** is listed before the tabs.

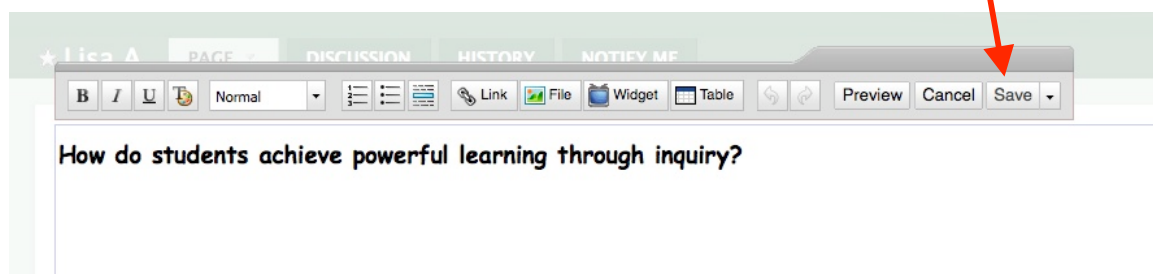
The tab in light green is your **front page**. This is where you can keep your line of learning. If you want, you can also add class notes here.

To add to the page, click on the **edit tab** on the far right side of the page.

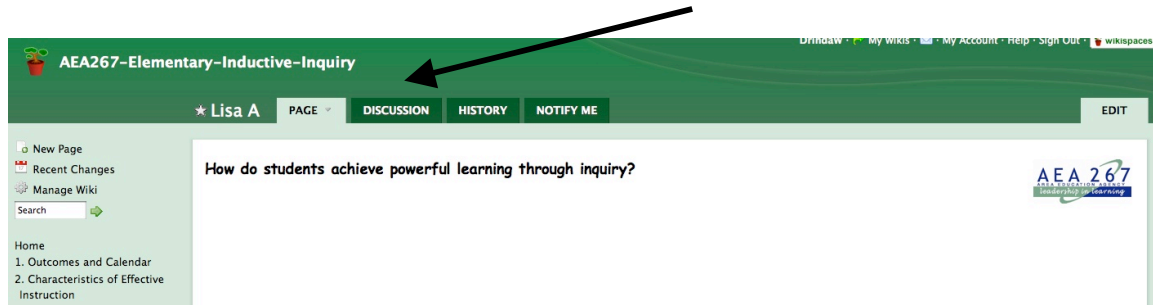
Take the time now to click on edit. Add today's date and copy your baseline Line of Learning onto the page.



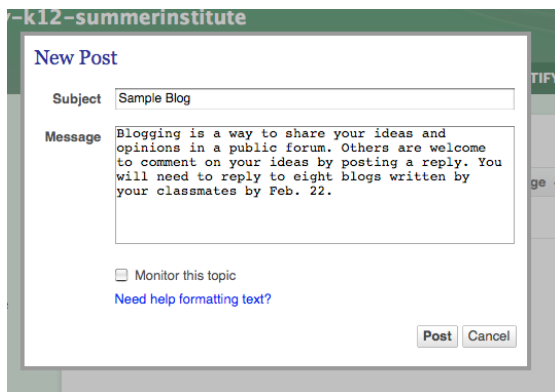
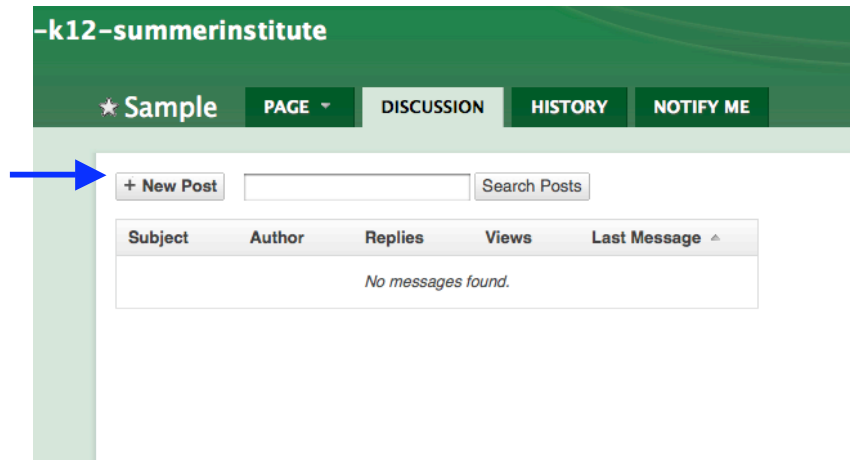
After you have changed your page, be sure to click on the **save button**.



To post your discussion entries, click on the **discussion** tab.



On the discussion page, you will click on "+ New Post" to enter your reflection, opinion, or ideas.



A pop-up window will appear for you to enter a subject and your message.



You will discuss the articles we assign, your practice lessons, or other ideas.

You must post eight entries in all. These may be your original entries and/or replies to classmates' posts.

To reply to a classmate, choose the name from the menu on the far left. Then click on the discussion tab. If there is a blog posted, it will look something like this:

Click on the **title** of the blog under the subject column. It will be blue in color.


